- 1st Term: 100 | 0

➔ **The S3 global mark is calculated as an average of the three terms.**

- 4th Term: 20 | 80
- 5th Term: 20 | 80 (40% mock)
- 6th Term: 100 | 0

➔ **The S4 global mark is calculated as:**
 $4^{\text{th}} \text{ term mark} * 0.45 + 5^{\text{th}} \text{ term mark} * 0.45 + 6^{\text{th}} \text{ term mark} * 0.1$
